Dear Council President Albornoz:

The Montgomery County Chamber of Commerce (MCCC) has been and remains a strong supporter of funding the shovel-ready Capital Crescent Trail (CCT) project under Wisconsin Avenue. Unfortunately, the CCT was not included in recommended FY2023 - FY2028 Capital Improvement Program (CIP).

It is imperative that the CCT project be completed by the time the Capital Crescent Trail Mainline, between Elm Street Park and the Silver Spring Transit Center, is opened. This is an important priority for Montgomery County. When a commitment is made to communities who use the trail framework for commuting and recreation, those plans must be followed through.

It is MCCC's understanding that the Transportation & Environment Committee has recommended adding the CCT to the reconciliation list. MCCC commends this vote and strongly urges the County Council to ultimately support the CCT's inclusion in the finalized CIP. Further delaying this project imperils one of the most important non-auto infrastructure projects in the entire Metro Maryland region.
