The Montgomery County Chamber of Commerce supports ZTA 19-07 -- Telecommunications Towers – Limited Use and urges its approval.

Montgomery County's economy relies on innovation to advance economic activity. ZTA 19-07, which allows a pathway for fifth generation mobile networks, is vital to these efforts. The opportunities for innovation and advancement in health care, transportation, public safety, education, manufacturing, entertainment, and many other sectors cannot be understated. Surrounding jurisdictions like northern Virginia, the District of Columbia, and Prince George's County are already moving forward with 5G innovation, and it is imperative to the competitiveness of Montgomery County's economy that we do the same.
