The Montgomery County Chamber of Commerce ("MCCC"), as the voice of Montgomery County business, **supports Senate Bill 200**, which increases the maximum total amount of research and development tax credits that the Department of Commerce may approve; and applying the Act to all Maryland research and development tax credits certified after December 15, 2016. Specifically, SB 200 expands the existing R&D tax credit from \$9 million to \$20 million phased in over 3 years.

Initiatives to make Maryland a good place to start and grow a business need to be supported. Research and development is a critical component of ongoing success in a technology-driven knowledge economy. Access to capital, particularly for long-term efforts like research and development, is a particular challenge to business success. Providing incentives to companies that engage in this activity helps retain the entrepreneurs and innovation leaders that have started here and encourages them to expand their important work. This increased economic activity will grow jobs and expand the tax base.

For these reasons, we request a **favorable report on Senate Bill 200**.
