House Bill 854: Income Tax Rates - Reductions

The Montgomery County Chamber of Commerce ("MCCC"), as the voice of Montgomery County business, supports House Bill 854, which alters the State income tax rate for certain income of individuals; and applies the Act to taxable years beginning after December 31, 2018.

The proposal lowers the personal income tax for rate payers between \$3,001 and \$250,000 for a single and \$3,001 and \$300,000 for a couple filing jointly by .25%. Lowering the personal income tax has meaningful consequences as employers work to attract and retain the next generation of talent to grow their business. In addition, for the many entities that are pass through entities in Maryland, this reduction in the personal income tax will help the owner operators and partners in a pass-through entity, allowing them to invest more in their business.

For these reasons, we request House Bill 854 be given a favorable report.
